

Did you know?

- The last time Royall Schools asked for an increase in operational funding was 2004! Since that time, 77% of the schools in Wisconsin have asked for an increase in operational funds- that is 325 schools.
- 137 schools will have a question on this November's ballot!
- The state aide we receive is based on per pupil formula. Like many other schools, our enrollment has been on a consistent decline for over 10 years.

What are our priorities with an approved referendum?

- The ability to continue to offer a wide range of academic offerings for all of our students
- No staffing cuts that would negatively impact our students
- The ability to keep small elementary and intermediate classes
- The ability to retain and recruit highly qualified staff




Revenue Limit Fund 39 Fund 80 Property Tax Chargeback/Other

We are asking for an increase in local tax revenue of \$1,500,000 each year for the next four years.

Fund Balance Summary



DPI recommends a school's fund balance is at 15% of their budget. To have a balanced budget, we have been steadily taking from our fund balance for several years and are now projected to fall dangerously below where it should be at.

What has the District already done to decrease the deficit in the last 2 years?

- Reduced teaching staff by 3.5 positions.
- Reduced support staff by 3 positions.
- Eliminated one bus route.
- Adjusted CESA contracts to minimal services.
- Reduction in athletic budgets.
- Reduction in classroom supply budgets.
- Maximized technology grants for needed technology resources.

What happens IF the referendum does NOT pass

Reduction of all contracted services including nursing.

Reduction in field trips including college tours & career exploration.

Reduction in support staff.

Reduction in extra-curricular offerings (athletics) with drastic cuts in 25-26.

Reduction in college course offerings in 25-26.

Reduction of up to 6 teaching staff in 25-26.

Reduction in middle and high school course/program offerings in 25-26

Eliminate additional bus route(s)

If an operational referendum fails in November and again in April, we will not be able to ask again until

November 2026.
